


Does it LOOK right?



Visual/Graphophonics

Error is visually similar to the word in the text.

EXAMPLE:

Text: Mom made us some cupcakes.

Student: Mom makes us some cake.

Does it SOUND right?



Structure/Syntax

Error makes sense & follows the rules of standard English.

EXAMPLE:

Text: She slid down the big slide.

Student: She slides down the big slide.

Does it **MAKE SENSE?**



Meaning/Semantics

Error does/doesn't make sense.


EXAMPLE:

Text: My dog ran down the road.

Student: My dog runs down the street.

CHUNKY MONKEY

Look for the small chunks
you know inside of the
bigger words.




STRETCHIN' STEPHANIE

Stretch out the sounds in
the word and blend them
together.



LISTENING EAR

Listen carefully as you read the
sounds in the word. Does the
sound match the letter? Does
the word make sense?



READY TO READ MOUTH

Get your mouth ready.
Make the beginning sound
of the word.



LOOKS CLOSELY LARRY

Look at the picture carefully.
Use the picture clues to
decode tricky words.




FLIP FLOP SOUNDS

“Flip Flop” the vowel sound. If you tried the word using a short vowel sound, try the word using a long vowel instead. Reread the word. Does it make sense?



TURTLE TALK

Say the word very slowly.
Blend the sounds together as
you stretch them out.



SKIPPY SKIPPER

Skip over the tricky word.

Read the rest of the
sentence and go back and
try again.









Meaning

I am reading when I come to a word I can't decode. I tried to stretch out the sounds. I looked at the picture closely. What can I do now?

I read a word that makes sense in the story, but the word that I said doesn't match the way the word starts on the page. What should I do?

I am reading a sentence when I come to a word that makes me stuck. I got my mouth ready and tried to stretch it out, but I can't decode the word. What should I do?

I am looking very carefully at the picture, but the word I'm saying doesn't match the word on the page. What can I do to help decode the word?

I am reading when I see a word that I don't know, but I know all the sounds in the word. What strategy should I use to decode the word?

I am reading a sentence that looks right, but it doesn't make any sense. What strategy should I use to make the sentence make sense?
