## **Afternoon Activity Ideas**

- Reading Lodge or Pier (where kids can just kick back in comfort and simply have time to read....)
- Creative Writing (bookmaking, comics, etc.)
- Computers (use PowerPoint, Word, Paint, etc. to produce projects)
- In-depth Investigators (students should be given a topic, e.g. tents, and find facts out about who made them, the best materials, the best company to buy) \*need access to computer lab
- Music (sight word songs, camp songs, space songs)
- Physical Education (Spark PE program, a literacy-based PE program)
- Art (each activity should be theme-based) \*will need to purchase materials such as air-dry clay, construction paper, glue, etc.
- **Practical Pointe** (activities such as tent set ups, map making, first aid, knot tying, making sandwiches, dental hygiene, etc.)
- Reader's Theatre (where students can produce their own theatre)
- Centers Corner (skills-based reading and math center activities)
